1. Introduction

- 1.1. This website can be accessed at **www.shotright.co.za**, related mobi-sites and software applications (the "**Website**") and is owned and operated by Flip Online (Proprietary) Limited ("**shotright**", "we", "us" and "our").
- 1.2. These Website Terms and Conditions ("**Terms and Conditions**") govern the ordering, sale and delivery of Goods, and the use of the Website.
- 1.3. These Terms and Conditions are binding and enforceable against every person that accesses or uses this Website ("you", "your" or "user"), including without limitation each user who registers as contemplated below ("registered user"). By using the Website and by clicking on the "Register Now" button on the Website, as may be applicable, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
- 1.4. The Website enables you to shop online for an extensive range of goods including sport, home and kitchenware, baby and toddler products, electronics, health and beauty products, movies and TV, gaming, books, music, toys, pet supplies, and more ("**Goods**").
- 1.5. Sho't Right allows Third-Party sellers to list and sell their Goods on the Website (each a "Third-Party Seller"). Sho't Right will indicate on relevant product pages and checkout pages when Goods are for sale by a Third-Party Seller. Certain terms in these Terms and Conditions only apply to purchases from Third-Party Sellers, and others only apply to purchases from Sho't Right. This will be made clear in the relevant clause.

2. Important Notice

- 2.1. These Terms and Conditions apply to users who are consumers for purposes of the Consumer Protection Act, 68 of 2008 (the "CPA").
- 2.2. These Terms and Conditions contain provisions that appear in similar text and style to this clause and which -
 - 2.2.1. may limit the risk or liability of Sho't Right or a Third-Party; and/or
 - 2.2.2. may create risk or liability for the user; and/or
 - 2.2.3. may compel the user to indemnify Sho't Right or a Third-Party; and/or
 - 2.2.4. serves as an acknowledgement, by the user, of a fact.
- 2.3. Your attention is drawn to these Terms and Conditions because they are important and should be carefully noted.
- 2.4. If there is any provision in these Terms and Conditions that you do not understand, it is your responsibility to ask Sho't Right to explain it to you before you accept the Terms and Conditions or continue using the Website.
- 2.5. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions is intended or must be understood to unlawfully restrict, limit or avoid any right or obligation, as the case may be, created for either you or Sho't Right in terms of the CPA.
- 2.6. Sho't Right permits the use of this Website subject to the Terms and Conditions. By using this Website in any way, you shall be deemed to have accepted all the Terms and Conditions unconditionally. You must not use this Website if you do not agree to the Terms and Conditions.

3. Returns

3.1. Please refer to our Returns Policy for more information about returning products (and related refunds, replacements, or repairs). The Returns Policy is incorporated by reference (which means that it forms part of these Terms and Conditions).

4. Registration and use of the website

- 4.1. Only registered users may order Goods on the Website.
- 4.2. To register as a user, you must provide a unique username and password and provide certain information and personal details to Sho't Right. You will need to use your unique username and password to access the Website to purchase Goods.
- 4.3. You agree and warrant that your username and password shall:
 - 4.3.1. be used for personal use only; and
 - 4.3.2. not be disclosed by you to any Third-Party.
- 4.4. For security purposes you agree to enter the correct username and password whenever ordering Goods, failing which you will be denied access.
- 4.5. You agree that, once the correct username and password relating to your account have been entered, irrespective of whether the use of the username and password is unauthorised or fraudulent, you will be liable for payment of such order, save where the order is cancelled by you in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
- 4.6. You agree to notify Sho't Right immediately upon becoming aware of or reasonably suspecting any unauthorised access to or use of your username and password and to take steps to mitigate any resultant loss or harm.
- 4.7. By using the Website, you warrant that you are 18 (eighteen) years of age or older and of full legal capacity. If you are under the age of 18 (eighteen) or if you are not legally permitted to enter into a binding agreement, then you may use the Website only with the involvement and supervision of your parent or legal guardian. If your parent or legal guardian supervises you and gives his/her consent, then such person agrees to be bound to these Terms and Conditions and to be liable and responsible for you and all your obligations under these Terms and Conditions.
- 4.8. You agree that you will not in any way use any device, software, or other instrument to interfere or attempt to interfere with the proper working of the Website. In addition, you agree that you will not in any way use any robot, spider, other automatic device, or manual process to monitor, copy, distribute or modify the Website or the information contained herein, without the prior written consent from an authorised Sho't Right representative (such consent is deemed given for standard search engine technology employed by Internet search websites to direct Internet users to this Website).
- 4.9. You may not use the Website to distribute material, which is defamatory, offensive, contains or amounts to hate speech or is otherwise unlawful.
- 4.10. You may not in any way display, publish, copy, print, post or otherwise use the Website and/ or the information contained therein without the express prior written consent of an authorised Sho't Right representative.

5. Conclusion of sales and availability of stock

- 5.1. Registered users may place orders for Goods, which Sho't Right or the Third-Party Seller may accept or reject. Whether or not Sho't Right or the Third-Party Seller accepts an order depends on the availability of Goods, correctness of the information relating to the Goods (including without limitation the price) and receipt of payment or payment authorisation by Sho't Right for the Goods.
- 5.2. NOTE: Sho't Right or the Third-Party Seller will indicate the acceptance of your order by delivering the Goods to you or allowing you to collect them, and only at that point will an agreement of sale between you and Sho't Right or the Third-Party Seller come into effect (the "Sale"). This is regardless of any communication from Sho't Right stating that your order or payment has been confirmed. Sho't Right will indicate the

rejection of your order (by Sho't Right itself or the Third-Party Seller) by cancelling it and, as soon as possible thereafter, refunding you for any amount already paid.

- 5.3. Prior to delivery or your collection of the Goods, you may cancel an order at any time provided you do so before receiving a dispatch or delivery notice. After delivery or your collection of the Goods, you may return the Goods only in accordance with the Returns Policy.
- 5.4. Any order of a **television** will be subject to the condition that we obtain from you your valid TV licence number and your account holder ID. If we do not receive your TV licence number and your account holder ID, or your TV licence number cannot be validated, you will not be able to check out with the television in your shopping basket.
- 5.5. Placing Goods in a Wishlist or shopping basket without completing the purchase cycle does not constitute an order for such Goods, and as such, Goods may be removed from the shopping basket if stock is no longer available or the price thereof might change without notice to you. You cannot hold Sho't Right or the Third-Party Seller liable if such Goods are not available or are not available at the particular price when you complete or attempt to complete the purchase cycle at a later stage.
- 5.6. You acknowledge that stock of all Goods on offer is limited, and that pricing may change at any time without notice to you. In the case of Goods for sale by Sho't Right, Sho't Right will take all reasonable efforts to monitor stock levels and ensure that when stock is no longer available, that offers thereof are discontinued on the Website. However, we cannot guarantee the availability of stock. When Goods are no longer available after you have placed an order, Sho't Right will notify you and you will be entitled to a refund of any amount already paid by you for such Goods.
- 5.7. In the case of Goods for sale by a Third-Party Seller, Sho't Right relies on inventory information supplied by the relevant Third-Party Seller and Sho't Right accordingly bears no liability for any inaccuracies in the information supplied to it. Consequently, should you order any Goods from a Third-Party Seller which are in fact sold-out, any resulting dispute should be resolved between you and the relevant Third-Party Seller, your respective rights and obligations being as set out in these Terms and Conditions.
- 5.8. Certain Goods may not be purchased for re-sale. Should we suspect that any such Goods are being purchased for sale, we are entitled to cancel your order immediately on notice to you.
- 5.9. Please see details relating to Pre-orders in our Contact Centre: Pre-Order, which are incorporated by reference.

6. **Payment**

- 6.1. We are committed to providing secure online payment facilities. All transactions are encrypted using appropriate encryption technology.
- 6.2. Whether the Goods are for sale by Sho't Right or a Third-Party Seller, payment may be made for Goods via the following methods (depending on its availability and/or your eligibility to use such a method)
 - debit card; where payment is made by debit card, we may require additional information in order to authorise and/or verify the validity of payment. In such cases we are entitled to withhold delivery until such time as the additional information is received by us and authorisation is obtained by us for the amounts. If we do not receive authorisation your order for the Goods will be cancelled. You warrant that you are fully authorised to use the debit card supplied for purposes of paying the Goods. You also warrant that your debit card has sufficient available funds to cover all the costs incurred as a result of the services used on the Website:

- 6.2.2. credit card: where payment is made by credit card, we may require additional information in order to authorise and/or verify the validity of payment. In such cases we are entitled to withhold delivery until such time as the additional information is received by us and authorisation is obtained by us for the amounts. If we do not receive authorisation your order for the Goods will be cancelled. You warrant that you are fully authorised to use the credit card supplied for purposes of paying the Goods. You also warrant that your credit card has sufficient available funds to cover all the costs incurred as a result of the services used on the Website;
- 6.2.3. direct bank deposit or electronic funds transfer: if you pay via direct bank deposit or electronic funds transfer, payment must be made within 5 (five) days of placing your order. Sho't Right will not accept your order if payment has not been received:
- 6.2.4. Instant EFT;
- 6.2.5. cash on delivery is not accepted at this point in time.
- 6.2.6. all of the following are not accepted yet, and we are working on enabling them in the near future;
 - 6.2.6.1. eBucks;
 - 6.2.6.2. Discovery Miles;
 - 6.2.6.3. MasterPass:
 - 6.2.6.4. Vouchers;
 - 6.2.6.5. NSFAS | Cellbux Voucher; and
 - 6.2.6.6. Mobicred; and/or
 - 6.2.6.7. Nedbank Personal Loans.
- 6.3. The above payment options are explained in more detail in our Contact Centre: Payment, which are incorporated by reference.
- 6.4. You may contact us via our Contact Centre to obtain a full record of your payment. We will also send you email communications about your order and payment based on your preferences.
- 6.5. Once you have selected your payment method, you will be directed to a link to a secure site for payment of the applicable purchase price for the Goods.

7. Delivery of goods

- 7.1. Sho't Right and it's Third-Party Seller offers 2 (two) methods of delivery of Goods to you. You may elect delivery via:
 - 7.1.1. courier; or
 - 7.1.2. self-collection.
- 7.2. For more information about delivery, please see our Contact Centre, which are incorporated into these Terms by reference. Our delivery charges are subject to change at any time, without prior notice to you, so please check the Contact Centre for the most up-to-date information. You will see the applicable delivery charges in your cart when you check out.
- 7.3. Where it accepts your order, Sho't Right or the Third-Party Seller will deliver the Goods to you as soon as reasonably possible, but no later than 30 (thirty) days of receipt of your payment ("Delivery Period"). We will notify you if we are unable to deliver the Goods during the Delivery Period. You may then, within 7 (seven) days of receiving such notification elect whether or not to cancel your order for the Goods. If you elect to cancel your order, we will reimburse you for the purchase price.

7.4. Sho't Right's obligation to deliver a product to you is fulfilled when we deliver the product to the physical address nominated by you for delivery of the order. Sho't Right or the Third-Party Seller is not responsible for any loss or unauthorised use of a product, after it has delivered the product to the physical address nominated by you.

8. Errors

- 8.1. We shall take all reasonable efforts to accurately reflect the description, availability, purchase price and delivery charges of Goods on the Website. However, should there be any errors of whatsoever nature on the Website (which are not due to our gross negligence), Shot right and its Third-Party sellers shall not be liable for any loss, claim or expense relating to a transaction based on any error, save in the case of any
 - incorrect purchase price to the extent of refunding you for any amount already paid, or otherwise as set out in the Returns Policy.
- 8.2. Sho't Right shall not be bound by any incorrect information regarding our Goods displayed on any Third-Party websites.

9. Gift Vouchers & Coupons

- 9.1. Sho't Right regrettably does not offer the following at this point I time and should this change the terms and conditions will be updated accordingly:

10. Promotions and other discounted Goods

- 10.1.From time to time, we may offer certain Goods at discounted prices as part of a promotion event. These will be subject to certain conditions (as set out in these Terms and/or the Website), which define the scope of the Deal. If you buy a product within the scope of a Deal, you will pay the discounted price for that product (the "**Deal Price**").
- 10.2. However, if you buy a product in a manner that falls outside of the scope of a Deal, then you will pay the then current (non-Deal) selling price on the Website (the "**Normal Price**"), for each product that falls outside the scope of the Deal.
- 10.3. For example: if you buy more than one product in a Daily Deal, you will pay the Deal Price for the first product, but the Normal Price for all products thereafter. Alternatively, if you buy a product in combination with any other products that together do not constitute a Bundle Deal, you will pay the Normal Price for all such products falling outside the scope of the relevant Deal.

11. Liquor

- 11.1.Sho't Right and it's Third-Party Sellers does not sell liquor under any liquor licence number It is an offence in terms of South African liquor legislation:
 - 11.1.1. for any person under the age of 18 years to purchase, or attempt to purchase, liquor and/or to present false evidence of his/her age in order to access liquor; and/or
 - 11.1.2. to purchase liquor for or on behalf of any person under the age of 18 years.
- 11.2. Sho't Right and its Third-Party Sellers are committed to complying with all applicable liquor legislation and therefore will not permit the sale of any alcohol.

12. Vaping Products

12.1.No Vaping Products will be sold by Sho't Right and it's Third-Party Sellers.

13. Online Course Codes

13.1.No Online Courses and Online Course Codes will be sold by Sho't Right and it's Third-Party Sellers.

14. Third-Party Sellers

- 14.1.Sho't Right will indicate on relevant product pages and checkout pages when Goods are for sale by a Third-Party Seller. In such cases Sho't Right only provides the platform to facilitate transactions between Third-Party Sellers and Sho't Right customers. Sho't Right is neither the buyer nor the seller of these Goods unless otherwise specified.
- 14.2. The Sale formed on acceptance of your order (in accordance with clause 5.2) for Goods that are for sale by a Third-Party Seller is therefore solely between the registered user and such Third-Party Seller. Sho't Right is not a party to that sale.
- 14.3. The Third-Party Seller is solely responsible for fulfilment of delivery of the Goods. The Third-Party Seller is also responsible to provide an invoice to the registered user if required.
- 14.4.Not all Third-Party Sellers are registered VAT (Value-Added Tax) vendors. Only Third-Party Sellers who are registered VAT vendors may charge VAT on Goods sold and issue a tax invoice in respect thereof. If a Third-Party Seller is not a registered VAT Vendor, it may not charge VAT on Goods sold and will not be in a position to issue a tax invoice in respect thereof.
- 14.5.Because Sho't Right wants the registered user to have a safe and consistent experience, Sho't Right will assist in handling any returns under the CPA or the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act 2002 ("ECT Act"), by the registered user arising out of or in connection with the Sale between a registered user and a Third-Party Seller on behalf of the Third-Party Seller according to Sho't Right's own Returns Policy. Should such claim escalate into being a dispute, although Sho't Right is entitled to become involved in an attempt to resolve it, Sho't Right is not obliged to do so and any disputes must be resolved between you and the relevant Third-Party Seller alone.

15. Privacy policy

15.1. We respect your privacy and will take all reasonable measures to protect it, as more fully detailed in our Privacy Section on the website, which is incorporated by reference.

16. Changes to these Terms and Conditions

- 16.1. Sho't Right may, in its sole discretion, change any of these Terms and Conditions at any time. It is your responsibility to regularly check these Terms and Conditions and make sure that you are satisfied with the changes. Should you not be satisfied, you must not place any further orders on, or in any other way use, the Website.
- 16.2. Any such change will only apply to your use of this Website after the change is displayed on the Website. If you use the Website after such amended Terms and Conditions have been displayed on the Website, you will be deemed to have accepted such changes.

17. Electronic communications

17.1. When you visit the Website or send emails to us, you consent to receiving communications from us or any of our divisions, affiliates or partners electronically in accordance with our privacy policy as set out in clause 15 above.

18. Ownership and copyright

- 18.2. You will not acquire any right, title, or interest in or to the Website or the Website Content.
- 18.3. Any use, distribution or reproduction of the Website Content is prohibited unless expressly authorised in terms of these Terms and Conditions or otherwise provided for in law. To obtain permissions for the commercial use of any Website Content contact us via our Contact Centre.
- 18.4. Where any of the Website Content has been licensed to Sho't Right or belongs to any Third-Party, your rights of use will also be subject to any terms and conditions which that licensor or Third-Party imposes from time to time and you agree to comply with such Third-Party terms and conditions.

- 20.2. Notwithstanding the fact that the Website may refer to or provide links to Third-Party Websites, your use of such Third-Party Websites is entirely at your own risk, and we are not responsible for any loss, expense, claim or damage, whether direct, indirect or consequential, arising from your use of such Third-Party Websites or your reliance on any information contained thereon.

21. Limitation of liability

- 21.1.Sho't Right cannot be held liable for any inaccurate information published on the Website and/or any incorrect prices displayed on the Website, save where such liability arises from the gross negligence or wilful misconduct of Sho't Right, its employees, agents or authorised representatives. You are encouraged to contact us to report any possible malfunctions or errors by way of our Contact Centre.

22. Availability and termination

- 22.1. We will use reasonable endeavours to maintain the availability of the Website, except during scheduled maintenance periods, and are entitled to discontinue providing the Website or any part thereof with or without notice to you.

- 23.3. Nothing in this clause 23 or the Terms and Conditions limits your right to approach any court, tribunal or forum of competent jurisdiction in terms of the CPA.

24. Notices

- 24.1.For Notices, please e-mail admin@shotright.co.za to obtain the legal address in which to serve the notice to, as its address for the service of all formal notices and legal processes in connection with these Terms and Conditions ("legal address"). Sho't Right may change this address from time to time by updating these Terms and Conditions.
- 24.2. You hereby select the delivery address specified with your order as your legal address, but you may change it to any other physical address by giving Sho't Right not less than 14 days' notice in writing.
- 24.3.Notices must be sent either by hand, prepaid registered post, or email and must be in English. All notices sent -
 - 24.3.1. by hand will be deemed to have been received on the date of delivery;
 - 24.3.2. by prepaid registered post, will be deemed to have been received 10 days after the date of posting;
 - 24.3.3. by email will be deemed to have been on the date indicated in the "Read Receipt" notification. ALL EMAIL COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN YOU AND US MUST MAKE USE OF THE "READ RECEIPT" FUNCTION to serve as proof that an email has been received and must have an acceptable subject title.

25. Complaints

- 25.1.If you have a complaint about the goods or services provided by us or require information regarding our internal complaints-handling process, please get in touch with us via our Contact Centre on the Website.
- 25.2.If we are unable to resolve your complaint to your satisfaction or we cannot resolve your complaint within 30 (thirty) business days of you having notified us of it, you can approach the Consumer Goods and Services Ombud ("CGSO") to assist in resolving the complaint.
